The Village Public Works would like to remind you the dumpsters throughout the village are for household trash disposal only. Items other than household trash needs to be taken to the transfer station for disposal.

PROJECT UPDATE:

The 11st Street paving project is in full construction. The Utility lines on East 11th will be replaced and that area will be paved.

FRIENDLY REMINDER:

The Village is requesting property owners that have private property encroaching on Village right of ways to remove their items.

The village right of way for the streets is 90 feet which could be measured 45 foot each ways from the middle of the road. Alley right of ways are 20ft

The Village right of ways should be cleared of all debris. There are still several properties that had been identified as having personal property, vehicles or trailers parked in front of fire hydrants, over water meters and in the public access and the personal items have not been moved.

The location of these items have precluded contractors and village staff from being able to construct, maintain and clean up the areas. We're asking all village residents to be proactive and move items from these areas. We appreciate your cooperation in this beautification and clean up effort of Cimarron. Letters will be sent out to those property owners that have been identified as having personal property in Village right of way.
